#### **Course Outcomes:**

- a. Principles of Income tax & Law-I
- 1. Students word identify the technical terms related to Income Tax.
- 2. Students would determine the residential status of an individual and scope of total income.
- 3. Students would compute income from salaries, house property, business/profession, capital gains and income from other sources.

#### b. Principles of Income tax & Law -II

- 1. Students would discuss the various benefits/ deductions under Chapter VI-A of the Income tax act, 1961.
- 2. Students would compute the net total income of an individual.
- 3. Describe the concepts and features of assessment of profits and gains of individual proprietorship, Doctor, Advocate and Chartered Accountant as individual assessee.

## c. Indirect Tax Laws -III

- 1. Students would explain the various terms related to Goods and Service tax (GST).
- 2. Students would discuss the time, place and value of supply.
- 3. Students would compute the amount of CGST, SGST and IGST payable after considering the eligible input tax credit

### d. Indirect Tax Laws -IV

- 1. Students would discuss the time, place and value of supply.
- 2. Students would analyse whether a person is required to obtain registration under GST law.
- 3. Students would distinguish the difference between forward change and reverse charge mechanism and also to understand the difference between composite and mixed supply
