1. Preamble

Degloor College, Degloor is renowned institute in the jurisdiction of Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded. During the last 53 years, Degloor College has gone through several ups and downs and witnessed many changes in higher education process. The college was started in a small building in Mondha 1963 and shifted to huge campus of 22.7 acres in 1967. The teaching and non-teaching staff was and is committed to the profession and contributed their best in developing the college and welfare of the students in the region.

The department of Sports is well equipped with extensive play ground & well equipped Gymnasium. Students Interested in different games & sports are given necessary training & practice on the extensive spacious play ground of the college. Qualified personnel have been appointed to promote sports & games activities of the college. The department provides coaching to the college students for the preparation of various games.

Vai. Dhunda Maharaj Degloorkar College, Degloor is affiliated to Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded. It has long history of seventeen years. The college has leading departments in basic and applied subjects in Arts and Science faculties. The college also runs Post graduate department in Geography in Arts Faculty.

The Department of Sports has been established in 1998 keeping in mind that the students from the remote rural area should get physical training for different games. Since from the establishment, the students were selected in different sports at university and Inter-college level.

The department has organized successfully University level Inter-college Weight Lifting and Best Physic tournament in 2007.

The department arranges coaching camps of different sports, participation in Inter-college, Inter-university tournaments.

2. Collaboration:

DCD and College have mutually agreed to collaborate with each other in the following areas.

- **Training in sports and tournaments and coaching camps,**
- **Free access to informal play spaces.**
- **Consultancy work;**
- **Student training programmes,**
- Free access to Gym and well equipped instruments in Gym.

The available facilities and manpower of DCD and College will be utilized with mutual consent and subject to the feasibility. Both parties agreed to enter into a collaborative understanding on the terms and conditions enumerated in this MoU.

3. Terms of Collaboration:

a) DCD and College agree to enter into detailed agreements on case-to-case basis, with a defined, specifying the scope of work and mutual obligations, terms and conditions, financial arrangements, Intellectual Property Rights and similar contractual obligations.

b) The College agrees to obtain prior permission from DCD to state in any project proposal that the project would be carried out by using the DCD infrastructural or intellectual facilities. But the DCD will keep the right with itself to finalize the proposal of the project.

c) The DCD similarly agrees to obtain prior permission from the College to state in any proposal that the project would be carried out by using the College infrastructural or intellectual facilities.

Either party while according permission may designate an authority in its own institute who can accord permission and monitor the project.

1. In case either party wins a consultancy project by projecting this MoU, a liability is created immediately in respect of royalty/premium due to either party. Either party shall concur with liability to the extent of contribution to the output of the project. Both the parties will arrive at the exact amount of liability after mutual consent.

2. Disclaimer:

This MoU is not intended by DCD and the College to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, agency, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind. Each party here acts as independent entity and neither shall act as an agent of either organization for other purposes. Neither party has the authority to bind the other party.

3. Non-exclusivity:

The agreement reflected by the provisions of this MoU is non-exclusive in nature and both the parties can enter into cooperative arrangements with other parties to suit their organizational needs.

4. Confidentiality:

The parties understand that in the course of their association, they shall have access to confidential information provided by the other party. Accordingly, the parties agree that such information shall be maintained in the strictest confidence and trust, except such information which is by its nature, not confidential or which is in the public domain or which the party comes to know about other than through violation of any law of legal obligation, provided that such party may be entitled to disclose such information if legally required to be disclosed to a competent authority. Failure to maintain confidentiality shall entitle the affected party to terminate the MoU.

5. Validity:

This MoU would remain valid for a period of Two years from the date it is signed by the parties and is renewable on mutual consent for such further period as agreed upon.

6. Term and Review:

The MoU shall be reviewed at the end of one year from the date of signing of this MoU. Either party can terminate the MoU after giving one months notice to the other party subject to fulfillment of commitments already agreed upon.

7. Amendments:

This MoU constitutes the entire understanding between the parties here to. Except as otherwise provided herein, no addition, amendment to or modification of this MoU shall be effected unless it is in writing and signed by and on behalf of both parties by their respective authorized signatories.

8. Any Dispute:

Any dispute arising out of this MoU will be settled by mutual negotiations between the two parties.


